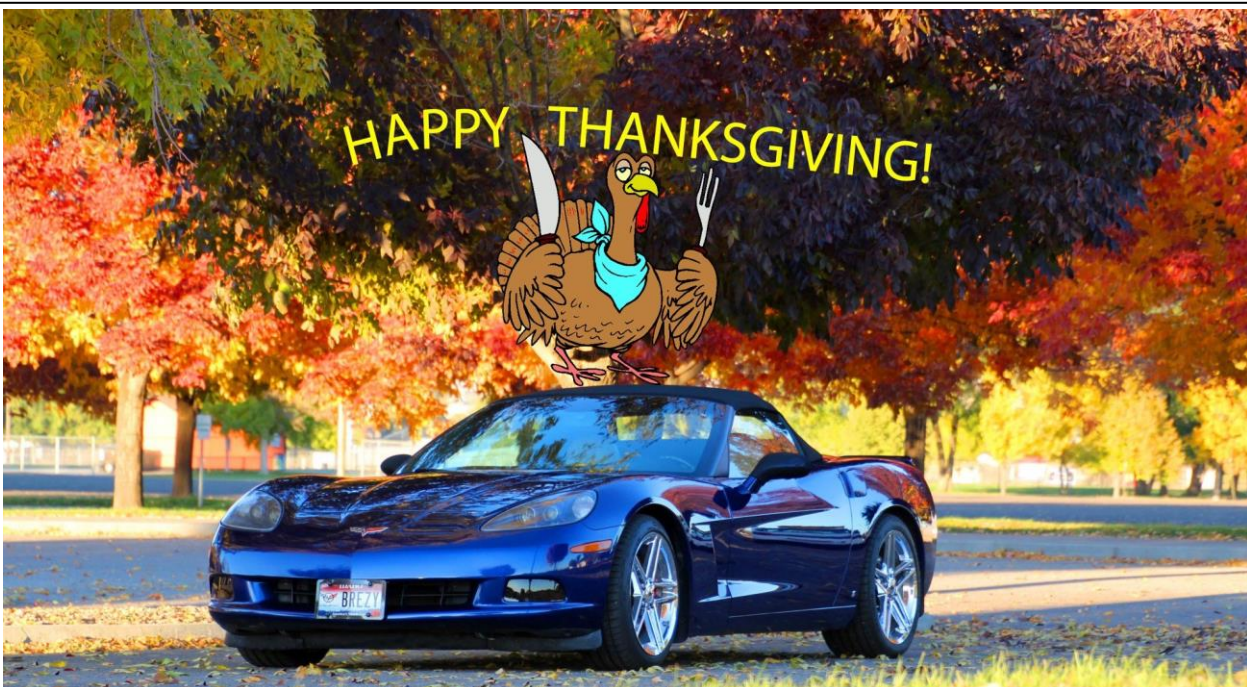

November is the month we hold elections for Club officers.

I have attached a short section of the by-laws of the Club (the full version is available on the club web site: <http://nothshorecorvettes.com./>) for your review.

The Executive E-Board shall have the responsibility and authority to act on all activities of NSCM.

Article 5 / Section 1 Officers:

A. The Offices of NSCM shall compromise the Executive-Board or otherwise referred to as the E-Board.

B. The Officers are as follows:

- a. President
- b. Vice President
- c. Secretary
- d. Treasurer
- e. Director of Cruise Nights and Shows
- f. Director of Membership

g. Webmaster/Newsletter Editor 9

Article 5 / Section 2 Terms of Office

A. The term of the elected officers shall be two (2) years starting January 1st following the election and running through December 31st of the second year.

B. Members holding office will be limited to two (2) consecutive terms in that position. After two (2) terms in the same office, they may run and be elected to a different office, which will then carry the same two (2) consecutive term limit. This term limit can be over-ridden by a majority vote of the membership at the nominations club meeting(s), thereby allowing the incumbent to run for an additional 2-year term.

This is to eliminate “no candidate” or uncontested elections

C. In the event of any unusual circumstances that could prevent the transition of a new E-board being nominated and elected, the existing E-Board will remain intact until proper nominations and elections can be held.

Article 5 / Section 3 Selection of Officers

A. Any Member seeking to hold an elected or non-elected E-Board position must be a member in good standing for 1 year prior to being nominated.

B. Under Massachusetts State Laws of Inc., the Secretary must be a Massachusetts resident.

C. Nominations for officers will be taken at the October Monthly Meeting.

The Nominee must be present to accept the nomination

D. There shall be no nominations accepted after the November general monthly meeting Officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the attending members at the December Monthly Membership Meeting.

E. If a candidate for any office runs unopposed; the Secretary will cast one (1) vote for the office in question.

F. All officers will assume their duties effective January 1st. At any time during the year at a meeting a member may ask for a vote of confidence of any existing officer(s) of NSCM to take place at the next meeting.

G. To retain his or her office the officer(s) in question must get a majority vote of the members in attendance at the next meeting. This vote must be done in written ballot following all the rules for the election of officers.

H. If he or she is voted out of office nominations for replacement should be made at this meeting with a vote at the next month's meeting for the replacement. I. Husband and spouse or significant other may be elected to the board in any open position is open for election or a vacancy on the board exits

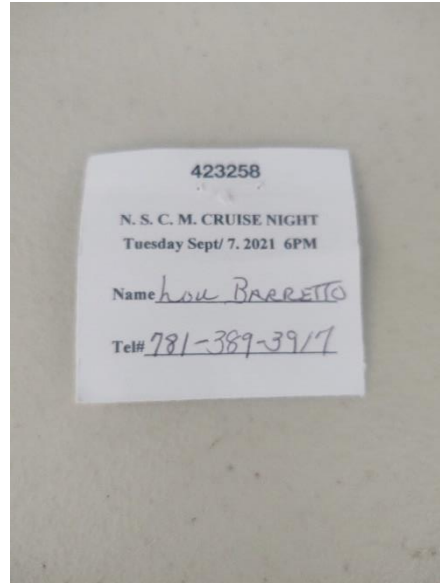

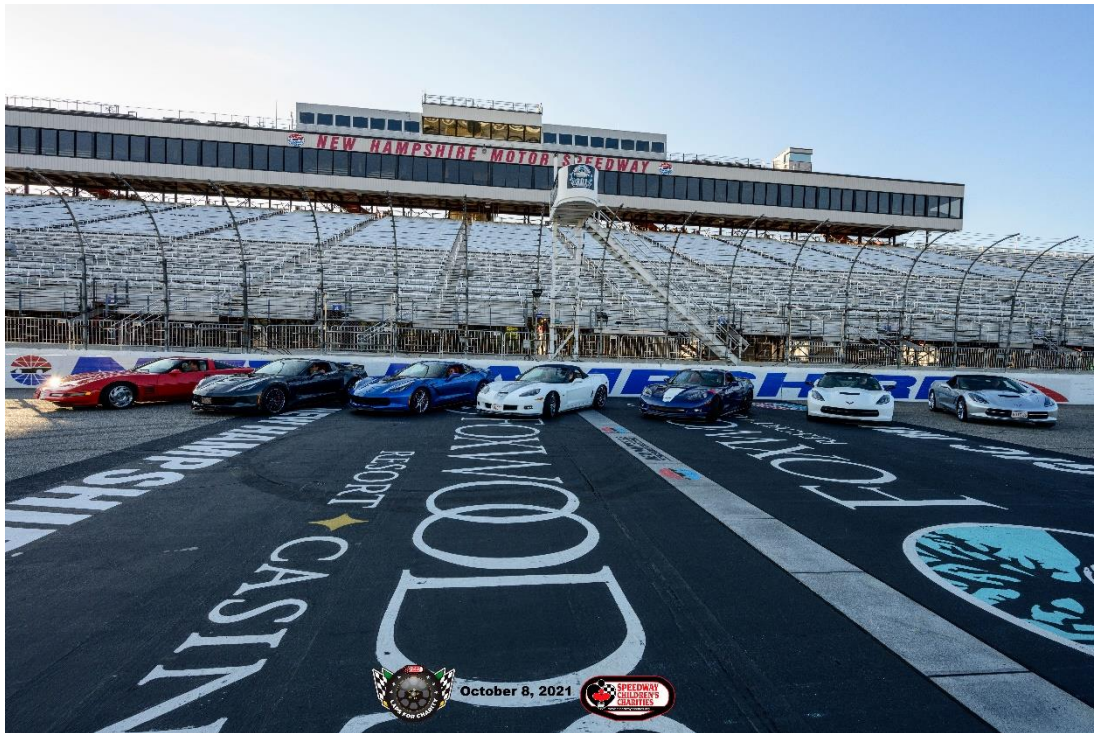

TECH TALK:



One and Done: GM Discontinuing Its 755-HP LT5 Engine

After just a year of service, it looks like the most powerful engine in GM's arsenal is riding into the sunset.

Well, we could hardly believe the news a few months ago when it was announced that Chevrolet's supercharged LT5 would be discontinued after one year of production, but it appears to be true. The LT5 is officially discontinued. This was GM's most powerful engine, and amid a horsepower war between the Big Three, it just seemed odd to kill off such a capable 755-horsepower/715-lb-ft performer.



We guess one-and-done is a good phrase for the LT5, as it was only stuffed into the insane, record-breaking 2019 ZR1 Corvette. The '19 ZR1 fielded the LT5, and Chevrolet wanted that car so bad

that it built it even though the taller LT5 blower (compared to the LT4) meant it couldn't be sold in Europe. We imagine it was pretty expensive to develop the LT5, and it was installed in fewer than 3,000 vehicles.



But while the 2019 ZR1 Corvette was cool, we're here to talk about the demise of Chevrolet's most potent crate engine. With production stopped, most of the existing LT5s are gone from dealership inventories. You can still find them around, so if you have about \$19,000 laying around and you want one for your hot rod swap project, then you had better get busy, as we're pretty sure the price is only going to go up as the remaining supply dwindles.

What's The Difference Between an LT5 And LT4 Engine?

Think of the LT5 as the big brother of the LT4, with most of the changes in the blower area. The LT5's supercharger grew from the LT4's 1.7 liters to a newly developed R2650 Twin Vortices 2.65-liter supercharger, which was designed by GM's Small-Block Group working with Eaton's engineers. The LT5's four-lobe compressor rotors are larger in diameter and longer, with a tighter 170-degree helical twist than the LT4's 160-degree-twist rotors. The LT5 produces 14 pounds per square inch of boost, compared to the LT4's 9.4 psi. The passenger-side rotor is driven by the crankshaft pulley through an 11-rib belt (three ribs more than the LT4) with a pulley ratio of 2.4 to 1 for 15,860 rpm compared to the LT4's ratio of 3.1 to 1. All of the changes were good for 105 horsepower and 65 lb-ft more torque compared to the LT4.

Will The LT5 Be Used in The C8 Corvette?



Although discontinuing the LT5 after such a low volume of production does not make a lot of financial sense, we really can't



see GM stuffing it into the C8 mid-engine Corvette since GM seems to be moving in the direction of turbos and technologies such as flat-plane-crank engines for the Corvette. This would mean the C8's naturally aspirated LT2 will be the only pushrod mill powering a Corvette, with future Corvettes getting power from new engine designs, not the LT5.

The [2022 Corvette](#) represents the third model year of the eighth-generation Corvette, otherwise known as the [Corvette C8](#). As such, the mid-engine [Corvette](#) will receive a few minor changes and updates to the only C8 model currently available – the [C8 Stingray](#).



Exterior

On the outside, the 2022 Corvette sees the deletion of three exterior color options as well as the addition of three new hues:

New Exterior Colors:

- Caffeine Metallic
- Hypersonic Gray Metallic
- Amplify Orange Tintcoat

Deleted Exterior Colors:

- Zeus Bronze Metallic

- Shadow Gray Metallic
- Sebring Orange Tintcoat

The mid-engine sports car also sees the deletion of the staggered, 5-spoke Performance Pewter-painted aluminum wheels (**RPO code** 5DG), which were a dealer-installed (LPO-level) option.



Conversely, the 2022 Corvette sees the addition of several new LPO-level options, including:

- Low rear spoiler and front splitter
- Black Ground Effects (LPO-level item)
- Visible Carbon Fiber door intake trim (LPO-level item)
 - Not available at start of production
- High wing spoiler with visible carbon fiber (LPO-level item)
 - Not available at start of production

Interior

On the inside, the 2022 Corvette Stingray sees a single change: the addition of illuminated door sill plates, which are a dealer-installed option.





Mechanical

Under the hood, the 2022 Corvette Stingray sees **slight modifications** to the **6.2L V8 LT2** engine. These include updates to the fuel delivery and **Active Fuel Management** systems along with some minor alterations to the engine calibration. These updates were made to ensure the vehicle meets federal emissions standards.



Notably, the LT2 V8 will still produce 490 horsepower and 465 pound-feet of torque in standard form, or 495 horsepower and 470 pound-feet of torque when equipped with the optional Performance Exhaust system. These figures the same as they were for the 2020 and 2021 model years.



Packages

The 2022 Chevy Corvette also sees the introduction of the **IMSA GTLM Championship Edition**, which includes the following content:

- **Z51 Performance Package**
- Graphics packages that mimic the No. 3 Corvette **C8.R** and No. 4 Corvette C8.R race cars:
 - The No. 3 edition features an Accelerate Yellow body with gray graphics
 - The No. 4 edition has a Hypersonic Gray exterior with yellow graphics
- Yellow brake calipers
- Black-painted Trident alloy wheels with Jake logo center caps

- Carbon Flash-painted exterior mirrors
- Black-painted side rockers
- Black splash guards
- Strike Yellow and Sky Cool Gray upholstery
- GT2 seats (Competition Sport Bucket Seats are also available)
- Yellow seatbelts and a C8.R Special Edition numbered plaque
- Custom-fitted **indoor car cover**
 - Rendered to the appearance of either the No. 3 or No. 4 Corvette C8.R race car, depending on the model



For those who are unfamiliar with the product line, the Stingray Z51 Performance Package enhances the Vette's capabilities with the following upgrades:

- Performance brakes
- Performance suspension
- Performance exhaust
- Performance rear axle ratio
- Electronic Limited Slip Differential (eLSD)
- Z51 rear spoiler
- Z51 front splitter
- 245/35ZR19 front and 305/30ZR20 rear high-performance tires
- Heavy-duty cooling system



2022 Chevrolet Corvette Availability

Production of the 2022 Corvette Stingray began at the **GM Bowling Green plant** in Kentucky **during the first week of September**. As such, 2022 Corvette models should already be trickling into dealers and into customers' garages.



Looking ahead, the **2023 Corvette** is expected to see a few minor updates to the Stingray, while introducing the long-awaited **C8 Z06** variant.

Notably, the model in these images is not equipped with the optional Z07 Performance Package, which will add a **massive rear wing** that *GM Authority* was the first to report on back in January of 2020, along with other go-fast goodies like a front splitter with dive planes, stickier summer rubber and lighter wheels.

We'll probably have to wait until the **official debut on October 26th** to see a Z07-equipped **Corvette** Z06 without any camouflage on it. As a reminder, here's the original image of the C8 Z06 in Silver Flare Metallic shared by Chevy.
